Here is our topic for this half term. Please use it to aid your own research or bring items into class to support your learning. Have fun!



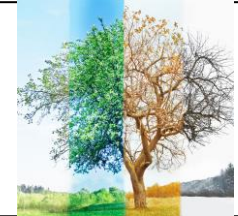
As Historians we will explore:
