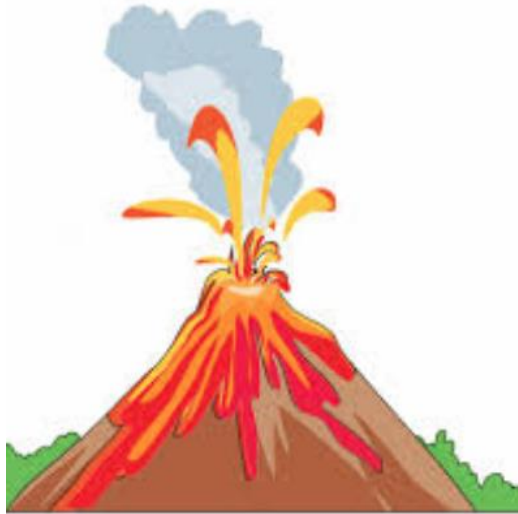


Dear Parents and Year 3 children:
