which they exist

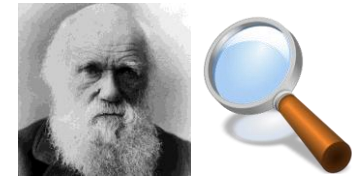
As Readers we will:
