LAS/Additional unit: Pilgrimages – What is a Pilgrimage and why do religious people go on them?

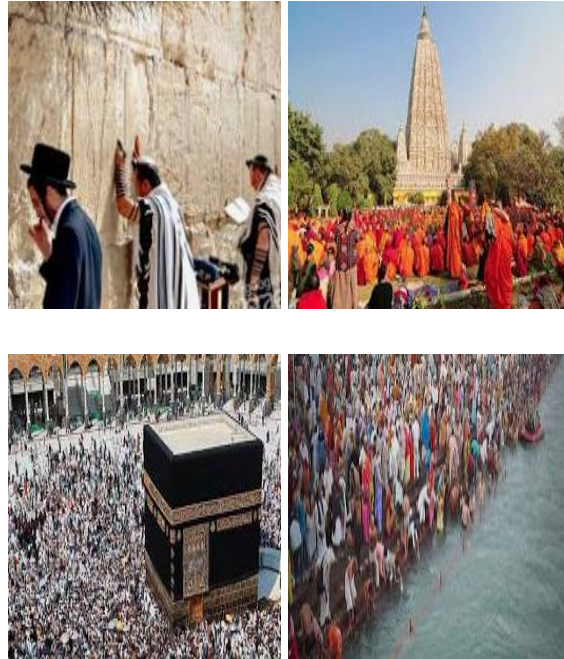
What should we know?
