<p>Recommended Homework: Individual book to be read at home at least 3 x a week and recorded in reading diary. Please can parents ensure they sign to show their child has read? Weekly spellings – Year 6 common exception words and focused words. Times Tables – Ensure there is rapid recall of all multiplication and division facts.</p>	<p>There will also be a menu of homeworks to choose from each week. Team points will be awarded for each homework completed. Handing in of these homeworks will not be required until the end of term in order to keep us all as safe as possible.</p>
<p>PE – 6M and 6F (Monday afternoon) Pupils need to have a white t-shirt, black shorts and black plimsolls for indoor PE. Outdoor PE: joggers, white t-shirt, sweatshirt and trainers We ask that children come into school on their P.E. day wearing their P.E. kit. They can wear this all day.</p>
