<p><b>Recommended Homework:</b> Individual book to be read at home at least 3 x a week and recorded in reading diary.</p> <p><b>Weekly spellings</b> – These will change weekly according to their target spellings</p> <p><b>Times Tables</b> – To learn and recap on ALL times table and division facts from 2 to 12.</p>	<p>Please send your child to school with a water bottle. Any bottle is acceptable but please write your child's name on them.</p> 
<p><b>PE – Wednesday afternoons</b> Pupils need to have a white t-shirt, black shorts and black plimsolls for indoor PE. Outdoor PE: joggers, sweatshirt and trainers Year 5 will be going swimming this year on alternative terms. <b>5L</b> will swim terms <b>1, 3</b> and <b>5</b>. <b>5T</b> will swim terms <b>2, 4</b> and <b>6</b>. Swim kit: swimming attire, a towel and swim cap (preference only)</p>  <p>Please remember, children should come to school in their PE kit on Wednesdays on terms where they <b>are not</b> swimming.
