#### Creation: UC – What do Christians learn from the Creation story?

##### What should we know?

Christians believe God the Creator cares for the creation, including human beings.

As human beings are part of God's good creation, they do best when they listen to God.

The Bible shows that God wants to help people to be close to him – he keeps his relationship with them, gives them guidelines on good ways to live.

Christians believe God made our wonderful world and we should look after it.

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.  
Now the earth was formless and empty,  
darkness was over the surface of the deep,  
and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.  
**Genesis 1:1-2**



##### What should we be able to do:

Make clear links between Genesis 1 and what Christians believe about God and Creation.

Describe what Christians do because they believe God is Creator.

Ask questions and suggest answers about what might be important in the creation story for Christians living today, and for people who are not Christians.
