Year 5	Additional Information						
<p><b>Homework:</b> Each week, we ask children to complete 30 minutes homework on IXL or TTRockstars. Each child has their own login and can choose on focus on English or Maths.</p> <p><b>Weekly spellings</b> – These will change weekly according to their target spellings. These will be given to children on a Monday for them to practise at home.</p> <p><b>Reading</b> – Children should be reading for at least 30 minutes a week outside of school. It is still important to listen to your child read if possible and note in their reading record when they read at home.</p>	<p>Please send your child to school with a water bottle. Any bottle is acceptable but please write your child's name on them. Children are <b>not allowed</b> juice or fizzy drinks in school.</p> 						
<p><b>PE – Wednesday afternoons</b> Pupils need to have a white t-shirt, black shorts or tracksuit bottoms and black plimsolls/trainers for PE.</p> <p>Outdoor PE: joggers, sweatshirt and trainers Year 5 will be going swimming this year on alternative terms. We may have the opportunity to swim in term 3 and 4 but this is still to be confirmed.</p> <p><b>5M</b> will swim terms <b>1, 3</b> and <b>5</b>. <b>5W</b> will swim terms <b>2, 4</b> and <b>6</b>. Swim kit: swimming attire, a towel and swim cap (preference only)</p> <p>Please remember, children should come to school in their PE kit on Wednesdays on terms where they <b>are not</b> swimming. Additional clothing, e.g. sports trousers and jumper, should be worn as appropriate.</p> 	 <p>Children are encouraged to bring in <b>fresh fruit or vegetables</b> for breaktime so ask that children <b>do not</b> bring crisps, chocolate, cereal bars or crackers as their breaktime snack.</p> <p>Please ensure that all children's clothing is named to ensure if it gets lost, it can be returned to its owner.</p>
