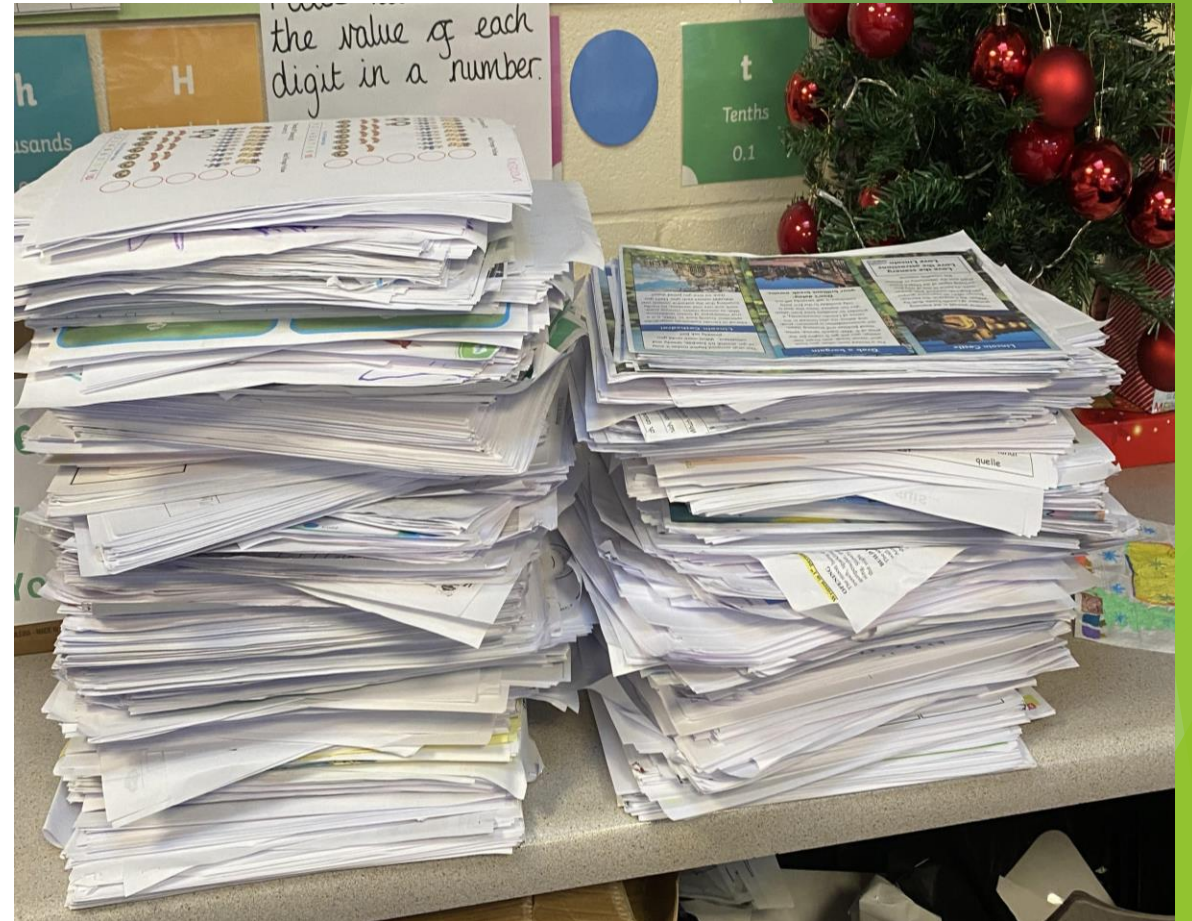


Eco-Club

SHARING THOUGHTS FREELY

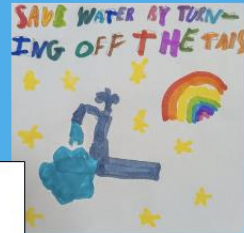

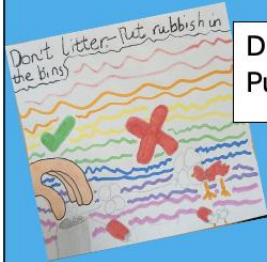
Eco-Club's Top Tips for saving the planet!
