Dear friends,

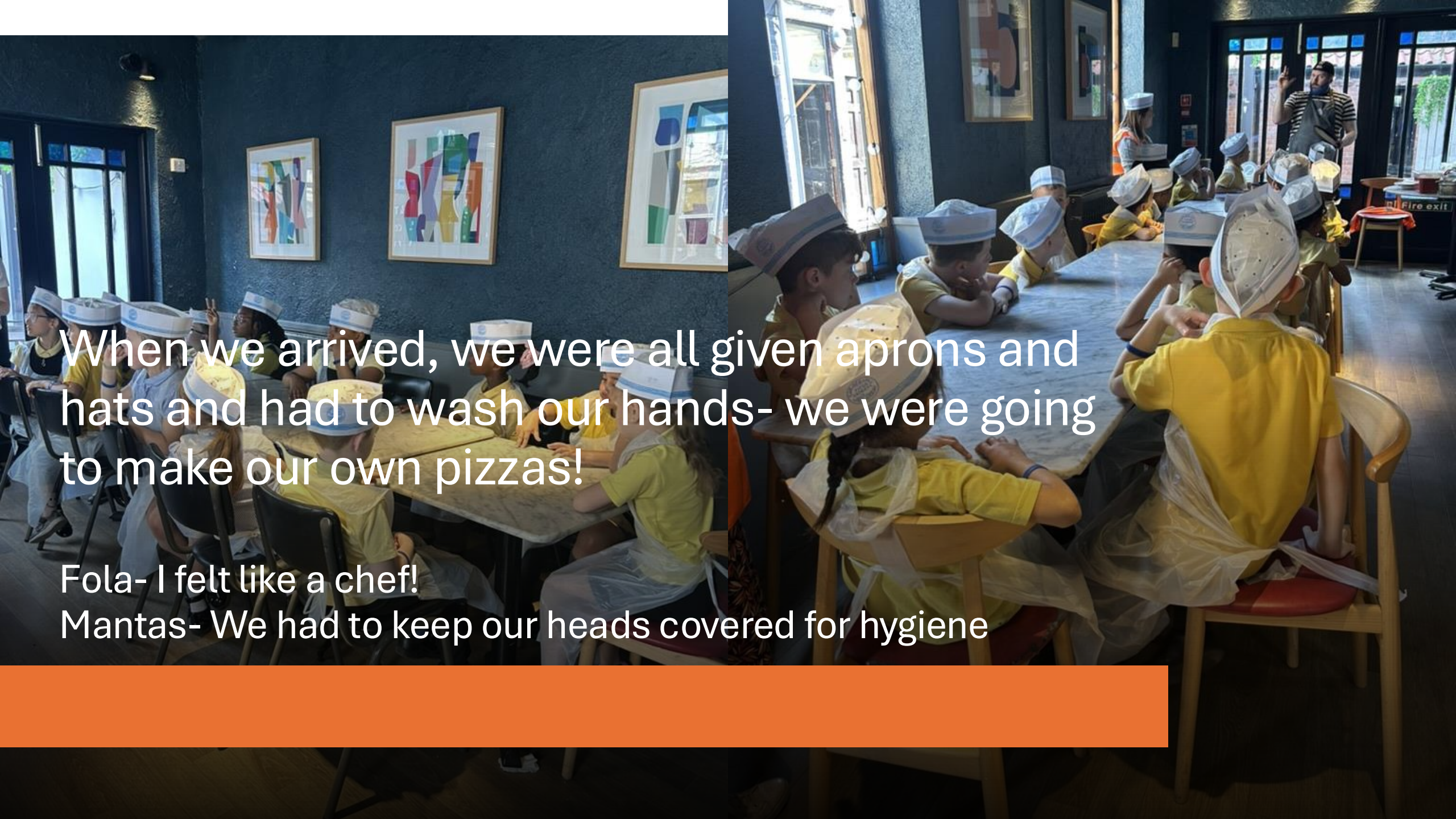
We hope you are all well and enjoying the cooler weather, it is getting very warm here, it has been 26 degrees C this week!

Finally, we took off our chef hats and aprons and were given our cooked pizzas in special boxes.

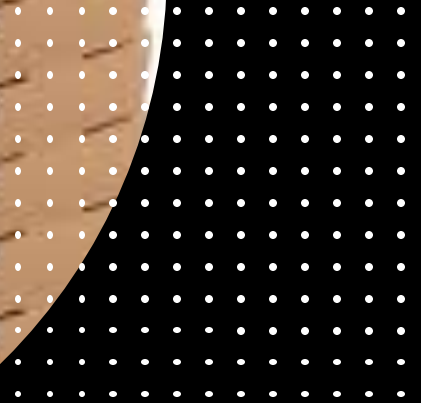
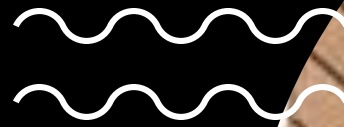
