What should we know?

- Hindus believe in reincarnation and spiritual freedom (Moksha).
- Hindus see life as a cycle consisting of 16 samskaras.
- That Hindu religious beliefs are based on a set of holy scriptures (the Vedas).
- Namkarna is the naming ceremony for a Hindu baby.
- The Sacred Thread ceremony purifies a boy so that he is ready for the next stage in his life.

- Understand how Hindus welcome a baby into a family.
- Name some of the samskaras linked to the birth and welcoming of a baby.
- Say why these milestones are important to Hindus and how they mark important events in life.
