Who can be a School Governor?

No special qualifications are needed to become a school governor.

However, if you take on this role, you will need to be interested in the work of schools, their teachers and pupils. You should also have enthusiasm for education processes.

What is the Foundation Governor role?

Foundation governors are particularly linked with the Church School status, but should be involved in all aspects of school life, not being afraid to offer a Christian viewpoint within any discussion.
