## Operation Encompass

In December 2019 we became an Operation Encompass School, becoming part of a national scheme which runs jointly between all schools and the police. Operation Encompass is reporting to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child or young person has experienced, any domestic abuse. Operation Encompass will ensure that a member of the school's staff – the Designated Safeguarding Lead, is trained to allow them to liaise with the police and to use the information that has been shared, in confidence.
