PE 2AR Monday afternoon 2AH Wednesday morning Pupils need to have a white t-shirt, black shorts and black plimsolls/ trainers for indoor PE. Outdoor PE: joggers, sweatshirt and black plimsolls/trainers. PE topics will include gymnastics, dance, send and return, attack, defend and shoot and hit, catch, run. We ask that children come into school on their P.E. day wearing their P.E. kit. They can wear this all day.	We will have 2 focused Art days in terms 2, 4 and 6 for 'clay pots', 'study of cubism' and 'still life drawing'. Please make sure your child brings a water bottle into school each day and it is labelled with their name.

Science - Summer plants.	 Please make sure your child's clothing has their name clearly written in it- especially their jumpers!  School will provide a piece of fruit for your child to eat at playtime.
