Weekly spellings – Year 6 common exception words and focused words. Times Tables – Ensure there is rapid recall of all multiplication and division facts. IXL – this is a digital homework source which your children have individual log-ins for. These log-ins are recorded in their reading records. Teachers will monitor the engagement for both the maths and the Grammar elements of this programme. This is accessible on laptops, tablets and phones. Any problems, please contact your class teacher.	Year 6 SATs will be administered this academic year, week commencing 8 th May 2023 To help prepare your child for these exams please support us by: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- ensuring your child is reading as much as possible at home.- practising times table and division facts. They could use TT Rockstar's.- practising Y5/6 common exception words.- engaging weekly with IXL.- ensuring good attendance.
