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

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Dear Parents and Carers,

<p>Recommended Homework: Please read with your child as much as possible. Individual books should be read at home at least 3 x a week and recorded in the reading diary. Your child will have a new piece of homework each Friday so please complete this with your child. Remember we write in lower case letters (not capitals) when your child is required to write. Please hand homework in by Wednesday of the following week.</p>	<p>Please make sure your child brings their reading book and reading record into school every day.</p> 
<p>PE Wednesday afternoon</p>  <p>Pupils need to have a white t-shirt, black shorts and black trainers or plimsolls for indoor PE. Outdoor PE: joggers, sweatshirt and black plimsolls/trainers We ask that children come into school on their P.E. day wearing their P.E. kit.
